Deadline for Posters and Oral Presentations: 25th of March 2011

The summary should contain the Title of the Presentation, the Names of the writers, the Institution or Association, e-mail and telephone number, the summary which should be up to 250 words and the indication for Oral Presentation or Poster

Maximum duration for oral presentations will be 15 minutes

Award for the best paper - 1.000 euros

Anyone whose oral presentation or poster has been accepted to be presented at the conference has the right to enter for the award. The papers have to be original, and follow the structure of: summary in the Greek and English language, introduction, method, results, and discussion. The text has to be between 1.500 to 2.500 words.
